**Robert Maier** is a professional Aikido-Teacher since 1995. **Kerstin Maier** is professionally teaching Aikido since 2001. Together they provide a permanent program for live-in students (Uchi Deshi) since 2005. Both have studied Aikido as Uchi Deshi in Iwama, Japan, under the direct guidance of Morihiro Saito Sensei (9<sup>th</sup> Dan Aikikai Tokyo) and became students of Paolo Corallini Shihan. With a letter of introduction from his former teacher Edmund Kern, Robert Maier went to Iwama in 1989 first time for four months. Until the passing of Saito Sensei a number of stays of several weeks with his wife Kerstin followed. Both are specialists for Ukemi (Taking Falls) and Aiki Ken/Aiki Jo. In the Aikido weapons program they hold the highest teaching license (5<sup>th</sup> level).
